The Heriot Bay Wharf is an unloading facility that serves more than 50 wild fisheries and aquaculture producers as part of the area's thriving shellfish aquaculture sector.

## 2 Heriot Bay Wharf project

The idea to provide capital upgrades to the wharf facility was part of a larger, five-phase upgrade project initiated by the Quadra Island Harbour Authority (QIHA) to improve the offloading capacity and industry productivity.

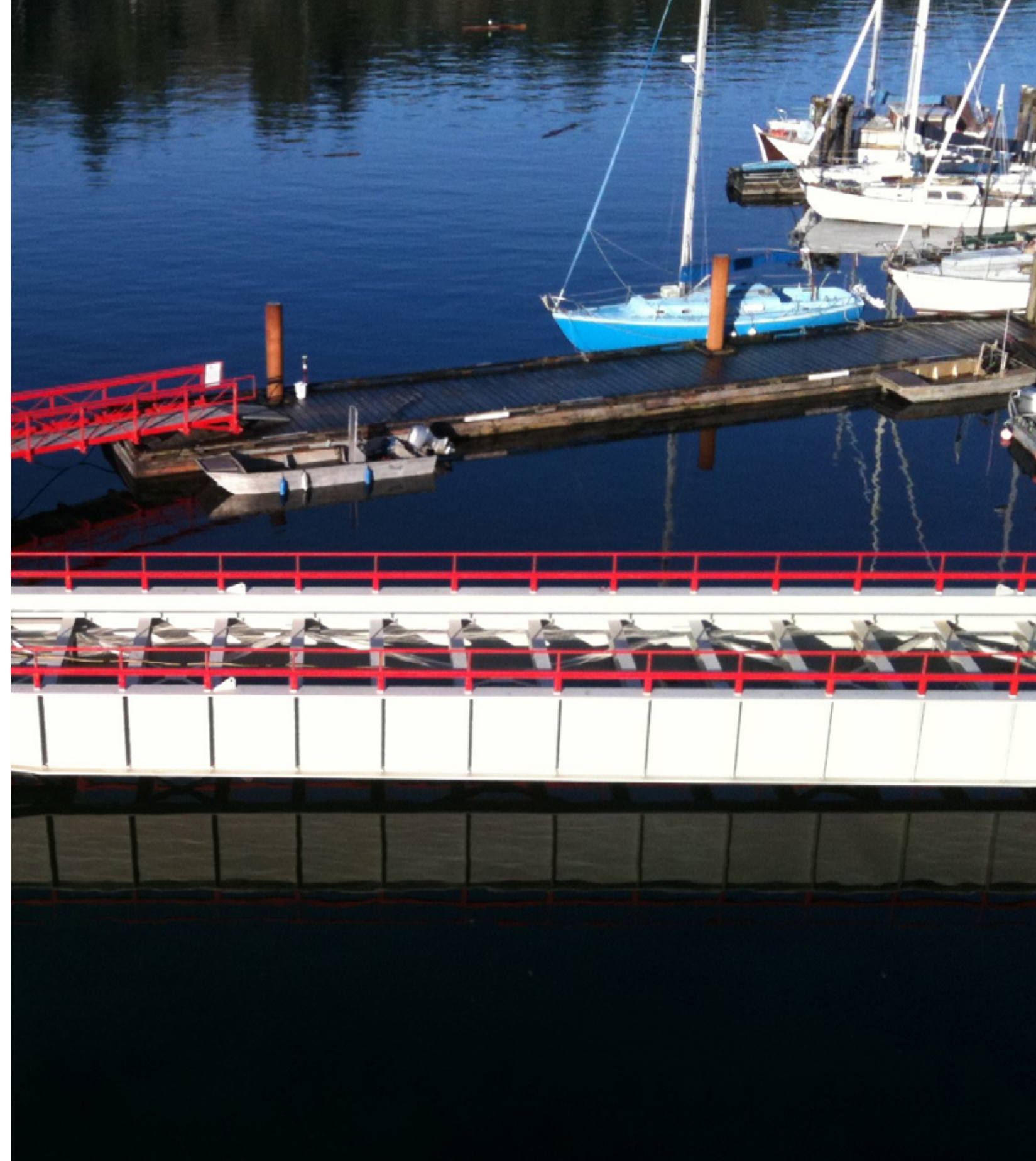
## 3 ICET Partnership

The QIHA received ICET support to construct concrete loading floats, mooring and pile driving, transportation, habitat approval and remediation, abutment and a ramp.



## 5 Community Impact

Local wild fisheries and aquaculture producers have benefitted from weekly productivity improvements and goods can now be transported directly to market or locally processed. As health and safety standards have also increased, producers are working in better conditions and producing a higher-quality, higher-value product.
